# Joint Meeting with Finance Council began at 7:00 p.m.

- I. Inspired by the Spirit Campaign Update
  - A. An update of our pledges, payments, and participation was shared.
    - 1. Goal: \$440,000
    - 2. Pledged: \$404,122.80
    - 3. Paid: \$166,982.85
    - 4. In parish account: \$77,113.56 as of 10/31/2023
    - 5. Participation: 124 Families.
- II. 2024 Diocesan Annual Appeal Update
  - A. An update of the current Diocesan Annual Appeal was shared
    - 1. Goal: \$57,870
    - 2. Pledged: \$15,750
    - 3. Participation: 52 Families
- III. Building Project Updates
  - A. Sprinkler System
    - 1. Was installed with minor issues, all resolved. The system was winterized, and they will be back in the spring to start the system
