




Image on Holy card distributed at Father Lyle's ordination.







FINAL COMMENDATION: Jesus Remember Me


Father Lyle would have liked you all to join in fellowship in the Parish Family Center to share your stories of him with each other, and have a great St. Joseph Parish dinner.
