II. Welcome: We welcome Mr. Joe Kinsella to our Council.

III. Old Business:

A. Elections:

- 1. We need to have a member volunteer to be the co-chair of the council and the secretary. Kristi has been the Secretary and can continue if that is the group's wish.
- 2. Ron Blaha offered to be co-chair, and all accepted. Kristi will remain secretary.

B. Youth Ministry Sweepstakes:

- 1. We are still waiting for the final donation to arrive to be able to share the final profits from the evening.
- 2. Approximately 160 people enjoyed the spaghetti dinner, and it was a great evening to view an outdoor movie.

C. Automated Chimes:
